If your entity is interested in receiving stuffed toys from the 2023 Teddy Bear Toss, please complete our Request Form attached and submit it via email to: Events@uwkern.org. The deadline to submit requests is Monday, November 13th by 5:00PM. Please make a note of the following:

- Requests for stuffed toys are limited to 100 per entity and Increment of 25
- Requests will be processed on a first come first serve basis.
- When requests reach the limit of 8,000 - entities will be placed on a waiting list
- Stuffed toys are to be utilized for entity's programs throughout the year.

Once requests have been received, entities will receive an email notification including distribution date, time, and location. The entity's personnel should come prepared and willing to collaborate with tasks which may include - sorting, counting, and bagging stuffed toys. 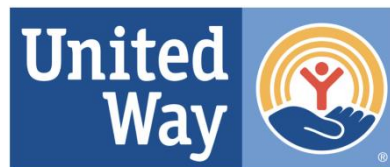
